Thank you for being a part of PPWSV's journey, and we look forward to celebrating many more anniversaries with you.






PPWSV is going to continue this inspiring collaboration and is looking forward to the next meetings.

This event was addressed to those of us who are wondering how to use leadership skills to boost hope in these difficult times and turn fear into action.




"PPWSV Academy: Hartmann Color Code Personality Workshop"


